

## Business Waste Modern Slavery Act Statement

Business Waste Ltd is committed to ensuring modern slavery is not present in its supply chain, and will continue to develop, policy and procedures to manage the way it obtains goods and services to keep its supply chains robust.

Business Waste takes a risk-based approach to working with high risk suppliers, and we are working on updating our supplier information pages and have contacted all our suppliers directly to ensure they are aware of these pages.

All our suppliers will be issued with new contracts incorporating our requirements on Modern Slavery and the buying teams have been trained in the importance of these requirements.

We have a clear framework of rules and behaviours and encourage the reporting of any concerns or breaches so that they can be dealt with appropriately in accordance with our policies and procedures. We offer an open-door policy where staff and suppliers can raise concerns confidentially and anonymously if they wish.

As employers we check that staff can demonstrate their eligibility to work in the UK. In addition, we use a preferred supplier list to contractors and who must undergo an eligibility check before commencing work with the company.
